Emelda Lomah is a young human rights defender. She faced challenges in her community when her uncle was accused by a witch doctor of being a sorcerer.

She went with her family to see the witch doctor to disprove her statements. As a human rights defender Emelda stepped in to ensure that her uncle's rights were respected.
